Year 11 Half-term update

I hope this finds you and your family well and trust that you are looking forward to an enjoyable half-term break. We have had a very busy half-term in school and you will shortly receive a copy of our Pindar Press newsletter - I trust you enjoy reading all about the special events we have had in school!

As you are aware, school closes for the half-term break at 3pm today. School reopens at 8.35am on Monday 28 February for all students. Please note that there is a planned training day on Tuesday 1 March when school is closed to all students, before reopening again on Wednesday 2 March. We have prepared a first draft of our holiday schedule for the next academic year and this is attached to this letter; it will shortly be finalised and placed on the school website for reference.

We have been informed by North Yorkshire County Council that they are no longer funding Free School Meal Vouchers via schools but are funding families directly via their household support fund (see link below)

This is available to families who are eligible for Council Tax reduction and does not relate to school holiday periods. If this applies to you, the Council should have already been in touch but they have asked us to share this message.

As we approach the final GCSE exams, we are working extremely hard with students to help them revise and prepare. Advanced information from the exam boards has been received and digested and students have practised revision techniques in tutor time. Our programme of after-school intervention activities continues and I strongly encourage all students to attend. In order to guide final revision, all Year 11 students will complete PPE or 'mock' exams from 14 March. Please encourage your child to revise thoroughly for these as all revision completed now will make a huge difference to the run-up to the GCSEs.
