Dear Parent / Carer

I hope this finds you well and trust that you are looking forward to the summer holidays. As we approach the final week of term. I wanted to give an update on the extreme weather predictions and let you know about the staff who are leaving us on Friday.

As you will be aware, there is an amber weather warning for extreme heat for Scarborough on Monday and Tuesday this week with a real decline in temperatures from Wednesday.
